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Salem Park, Recreation and Community Services is following all public health guidelines set forth by the state and our local health department. We will continue to update these guidelines.

Updated Summer Program Guidelines:

Screening and Monitoring:

- Staff, participants, and parents of participants must self- screen and be symptom free before arriving at any program.
- There will not be a Daily Health and Wellness Form required to be passed in at each program.
- If a child becomes ill during the program, the parent will be contacted immediately and asked to pick up their child from the program.

Face Coverings:

- Outdoor Programs: Face coverings are not required for vaccinated participants. The Department of Public Health advises that unvaccinated residents continue to wear face coverings when they cannot socially distance.
- Indoor Programs: Face coverings are required for all when programs occur inside at the Community Life Center.

Other:

- 6" social distancing is encouraged but not mandatory
- Shared equipment is allowed.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at each program site.

Quarantining:

- If a participant/staff tests positive for COVID-19 or is identified as a close contact, they must isolate or quarantine until they have met the requirements for discontinuing isolation or quarantine.
- A person who is symptomatic and tests positive can return after
 - At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared and
 - At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication and
 - Other COVID-19 symptoms are improving.
- A person who is asymptomatic and test positive can return after 10 days have passed since the date you had a positive test.
- Vaccinated individuals who are exposed to COVID-19 do not need to quarantine.
